1. Austin, Edward, 26, 28 May 1635. Persons to be transported (from London) to Virginia by the *Speedwell* of London, Mr. John Chappell.
2. Austin, John, 24, 1 August 1635. Persons to be transported (from London) to Virginia by the *Elizabeth* of London, Mr. Christopher Browne
3. Austin, Richard of Bishopstoke, (Hants), a tailor, age 40, his wife and 2 children and his servant Robert Knight, carpenter, May 1638. Passengers from Southampton intended for New England by the *Bevis* of (South) Hampton, Mr. Robert Batten:
4. Austin, Michael, 25 Jan 1659.
5. Austin, Jonathan Austin, bound to Sarah, wife of William Cottle, to serve 4 years in St. Christopher. 21 Nov 1660.
6. Austin, Margery, Spinster, apprenticed in Bristol to David Warren, mariner, 4 years Virginia 2 Jul 1661
7. Austin, Francis, yeoman, to Edith Holloway, 5 years Virginia, 5 July 1661.
8. Austin, Thomas Austin of St. Cement Danes, a Newgate prisoner who was reprieved to be transported to Jamaica, 24 August 1661.
9. Henry Jones, an apprentice in Bristol to John Austin, 4 years Virginia, 5 October 1661.
10. Jane Wood apprentice to John Austin, 4 years in Barbados [Carribean], 18 November 1661.
11. John Gunn apprenticed to John Austin for 3 years at Nevis, 3 January 1662.
12. Austin, Stephen, apprenticed to William Merrick for 4 years in Barbados, 21 June 1662.
13. Austin, John of St. Clement Danes reprieved from Newgate prison to be transported to the plantations. 16 January 1664.
- 14: Austin, John Austin, a prisoner at Middlesex reprieved to be transported to Jamaica, February 1665.
15. John Sturgion, alias Austin, alias Stevens, a Bristol prisoner reprieved to be transported to Barbados, 6 June 1666.
16. Austin, Valentine, a shipper by the Society bound from London for New England, 17-30 June 1668.

17. Austin, Valentine, shipper by the *William & John*, bound from London for New England, 20 April 1672-9 May 1672.
18. Thomas Gilbert, apprenticed to Thomas Austin, 4 years in Barbados, 7 August 1675.
19. Austin, Elizabeth, apprenticed in Bristol to John Whittfield, 4 years Virginia by *William & Ann* (ship) 25 September 1676.
20. Austin, Richard of Basingstoke, a Western Circuit prisoner reprieved to be transported to Barbados. 28 July 1677.
21. Austin, Samuell Austin, s shipper by the *Richard* bound from London for New England, 25 February 1679-3 April 1679.
22. Austin, Joseph of Shadwell, Middlesex, and late of New England, September 1679. Probate of will of Joseph Austin of Shadwell, Middlesex, and late of New England.
23. Austin, Thomas, age 27, a mercer [textile industry], 8 July 1685.
- 24.& 25 Austin, John, aged 22, and his sister, Elizabeth, spinster, aged 23 apprentices to Anthony Cornwell, merchant, for 4 years in Maryland, 20 October 1685.
26. Thomas Jones, apprentice to Thomas Austin of Limehouse, Middlesex, mariner, 4 years in Antigua, 2 December 1685.
27. Austin, Samuell, a shipper by the *Concord*, 3-29 November 1686.
28. Austin, Abraham, a shipper by the *Swan* bound from London for New England, 7 September 1688-2 October 1688.
29. Austin, Thomas of H.M. Ship, *Richmond*, who died in New York June 1694. Probate of will of Thomas Austin.
30. Austin, Josiah, a shipper by the *Samuel & James* of London, 16-23 November 1699.
31. Austin, Caleb, apprentice February 1706.
33. Austin, William of St. Giles in the Fields, Middlesex, a baker, age 19, bound to William Burge to serve 4 years in Maryland, 8 August 1735.
34. Austin, Matt, an unchristened black slave of H.M. ship *Winchelsea*, a bachelor, June 1762.
35. Austin, William, surgeon's mate of H. M. *Hospital* in North America who died in Albany, New York, December 1764.
36. Austin, Joseph of Hertfordshire, gardener, aged 18, an indentured servant to go from London to Maryland by the *Elizabeth* 1774.
- 37, 38, 39. Austin, Thomas of Dorset, attorney, aged 20, to settle, and his sisters Martha age 18 and Ann age 17. Passengers from London to Jamaica by the *Northampton*, Mr. John Barford

40. Austin, Sarah of Southward, servant, aged 25, to go from London to Baltimore, 5-12 June 1775. The following redemptioners to go from London to Baltimore by the *Baltimore*, Mr. James Clark.
41. Aston alias Styck alias Underwood, Dorothy. Sentenced to transportation for stealing at Broseley, Summer 1768. Shropshire.
42. Aston, Jane wife of Walter. Sentenced to transportation & reprieved for transportation, Lent 1775. Shropshire.
43. Aston, John. Sentenced to transportation May-July 1750. Middlesex.
44. Aston, Thomas. Sentenced to transportation for stealing at Aldridge, Lent 1727. Staffordshire.
45. Aston, Thomas (1750). See Smithiman. Staffordshire.
46. Austin, John. Reprieved for transportation 14 yrs Bristol October 1740. Gloucestershire.
47. Aust, Anthony. Reprieved for transportation 14 yrs July Transportation Bond to Virginia September 1756. Wiltshire.
48. Austin, Abraham. Sentenced to transportation July 1730. Devon.
49. Austin, Abraham (John). Sentenced to transportation stealing silver spoons & clogs July 1735. Transported January 1736 Dorsetshire Landing, Certificate Virginia September 1736. Middlesex.
50. Austin, Alice. Sentenced to transportation October, transported December 1771 Justitia. London.
