James Austin, res. Philadelphia, PA, died 5 May 1795, Philadelphia. He resided in Philadelphia as early as 1785. At the time of his death he was living on his estate at NW corner of 2nd and Shippen Streets, which property he purchased from Margaret McCale 5 March 1793. In the deed to him of that date (Philadelphia Deed Book p?, no. 39, p 344) he is styled "mill stone maker". Married Eleanor Brander, who died 24 Jan 1848, Philadelphia. She survived her husband and administered his estate but subsequently married a Mr. Alexander. She executed her last will and testament 20 May 1847.

By an agreement dated 24 Oct 1850 and recorded at Philadelphia in Deed Book G.W.C. No. 65, p 533, it appears James Austin left 5 children surviving him, 3 of whom died intestate and without issue. Names of but three children are known to writer:

1. Elizabeth, b 18 Sept 1785, bapt. the Second Presbyterian Church 22 Oct following and doubtless died in childhood.
2. John B., died 23 May 1815, leaving a widow Margaret, who administrated his estate 7 days later, and a son James who died unmarried and without issue.

No. 6. Council Records, p. 125, 204 1798-1846. Voted that Thomas Noyes and James Sheffield two of the overseers of the Poor of this town. If Jedediah Austin don't put out and bind his daughter Dorcas Austin between this time and the 26th of this instant then the Noyes and Sheffield to immediately bind out said Corcas/Dorcas.

From A. D. Miller, Asst to Administrator, to N. C. Griswold, Scotia, NY, concerning John Austin # 15674.

Dear Sir:

Reference is made to your letter in which you request the Rev. War record of John Austin, as pensioner of Vermont. The record of John Austin is furnished herein as found in the papers on file in pension claim # 15674, based upon his service in the Rev. War.

John Austin, while a resident of Preston, CT, enlisted sometime in May 1776 as a private in Capt. Oliver Coit, CT Company and served about five months, then enlisted in Capt. Richard Leshner's Company, Col. Hol?den's CT regiment; was in the retreat from Long Island, in the battle of White Plains, and was discharged Dec 25, 1776; he then enlisted under Capt. Penn? for two months and went to Rhode Island and was discharged about Apr 1, 1777; he enlisted about April 28, 1777, served as a private in Capt. William Belcher's Co., Capt. Colonels Huntington, Samuel Prentice, and Josiah Starr's regiment, was in the Battle of Monmouth and was discharged in Springfield, NJ; length of service 3 years. He served two months in the militia at Port Griswold, no officers named.

He was allowed pension on his application executed April 21, 1818, at which time he resided in Swanton, Franklin Co., VT. He was then 60 years of age, the date and place of his birth and names of his parents not shown. In 1820, soldiers son, John, aged 24 years, was living at home in said Swanton, VT. In 1833, the soldiers was allowed pension under the Act of June 7, 1832, he resided then in Swanton, VT. He died there Apr 20, 1841.

The soldier married Jan 16, 1783 Esther Herrick: their marriage was recorded in the First Congregational Church of Griswold, New London Co., CT. Esther Herrick was born 29 Oct 1762, the place of her birth and parents not shown.

Soldier's widow Esther Herrick Austin was allowed pension on her application, executed Aug 14, 1864, at which time she resided in Swanton, Franklin Co., VT.

She died July 27, 1853.
