Notes from Cash Williams

Cash's father was A. G. Williams. A. G.'s father was John Williams from Watertown, Jefferson Co., a Baptist minister. He came from Jefferson Co. in 1848. He (John) formerly lived in St. Lawrence Co.

John Williams with \$2,000 in gold which he carried in gold on his wagon was murdered in going west.

Notes from Reno White

David Austin, father's uncle, had three daughters:

1. Clarabell Austin studied medicine, lived in Boston - was a homeopath.
2. Belle married a Gale - lived at Wellesville.

Belle's son Morris Gale lives at Angola.

Belle's daughter, Clarabell Gale, married a lawyer. They lived in Albany for a time where he was interested in politics.

3. Amelia Austin lived in NY, was a spiritualist.

Some of the Nichols or relatives of them live at Black Creek near Cuba.

From Belmont

David Austin {brother of J. W. Austin of Ceres} was an atheist and liked to talk about. David Austin married Mehala Fisk. His son Royal was a teacher of penmanship. His writing was so beautiful that the Lord's Prayer and the Apostle's Creed were framed in his writing.

Royal, during the Civil War, was a prisoner in Andersonville prison. After the war he went west.

From Grandmother

Ceres, Sept. 18, 1870
Your aunt is staying here yet. She and I have been up to Bolivar to visit Henry Burdick. He married Olive Ives {no relative} and her mother lives with them. From Aunt Mate.

Ceres, Jan. 1, 1871
Marshall and Elmira are here. They came last night... The folkes are all well at New Hudson.

Ceres, July 6, 1871
Father and mother went to Belmont (the fourth). Bell Austin is going to be married this summer and Royal is already married.

Clipping - ("Mrs. Whipple, formerly Mrs. Willard {David Austin's daughter} of this town and now of Ohio, is lecturing with much success in Iowa").
Mother thinks you don't know who Melia Willard is, but she is your consin.

From Grandmother

Ceres, Aug. 28, 1871
To-day your Uncle Martin's folks, your Aunt Sally, Mate, and family start for Topeka. Satie Gere has an organ.

Ceres, Aug. 17, 1872
Gage and his wife and your Aunt Ives are here. I do not think your aunt will go back with them. She will probably stay and visit.

From Aunt Sate

Ceres, Sept. 2, 1872
Gage and Lou had been east all summer. I went to New Hudson and visited with them there two weeks, and when they started back, they came here and made a short visit. Aunt Sally did not go back with them. They went to Washington and Ithica [Ithaca] while here and back via Niagara Falls.

From Grandmother:

Allegany Bridge Jan. 23, 1873
Your Uncle Wm. and wife were here last week. They live down near Broken Straw where they did when you saw him last.

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Allegany Bridge, Eldred, Penn.

Tues. Jan. 25, 1873 - Lou Gere and All {brother} came so I had to stop. All is at work in a mill just below the bridge.

Now, Charles, as to your nationality. I guess we must put you down Yankee. Your forefathers as far back as we can trace them are from the New England States, descendants of the English except your father's grandmother. She was Dutch{?}, I think.

Mar. 23, 1873 - John's folks left last Tuesday. They have gone over towards Clarksville a little way beyond where Wm. [William] Austin used to live. {Scott's Corners}
